

Gray County Courthouse Restoration



ARCHITEXAS provided full architectural services for the restoration of this four-story 1929 Beaux-Arts style county courthouse. The project included preparation of a master plan, a Texas Historical Commission grant application and full architectural services for the complete restoration of the structure. The work included masonry restoration, window repair, roofing, new mechanical, electrical, plumbing and fire protection systems, courtroom rehabilitation and office rehabilitation. New restrooms were also provided. Non-historic additions were removed to expose the historic corridors and courtroom, which were then restored.
