

Grapevine City Hall



The Grapevine City Hall was designed to be a compatible and appropriate contributing element in the late 19th century historic context of downtown Grapevine. The city hall consolidated three separate office locations for city hall staff, council chambers and other city departments. ARCHITEXAS provided site analysis and site selection services and conducted an intensive user study, which included interviewing each department head and each staff member, to create the program for the building. The state-of-the-art council chamber and the exterior reflect features of an earlier building on the same site.
